Authors to Cite Reference and avoid Plagiarism.

Reference Style: ILI (Indian Law Institute) or APA reference style should be followed strictly.

Author Name and Designation: Author Name and Designation would appear under the Title of the Paper on the First Page / Abstract.

Authors and Co-Authors: There may be an Author and Co-Author for a research paper. Authors and Co-Authors have to pay their fees separately.
