## **2.5.1 - Mechanism of internal assessment is transparent and robust in terms of frequency and mode. Write description within 200 words.**

As the College is affiliated to The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University, Chennai the guidelines and rules framed by the University for internal assessment and evaluation are communicated to the students.

Academic Calendar is prepared before the semester starts and the dates for assignment submission and internal assessment test are communicated to the students well in advance through circular and the same is uploaded in the college website.

- Two assignments are allotted per student for each subject. Law papers will be mandatorily had one assignment as Case Analysis. The same is evaluated by the respective faculty and awarded marks based on the performance of each student.
- The college conducts 2 internal exams per semester to continuously assess the student's performance during the semester. Question papers for each internal test is prepared by the respective faculty handling the subject by looking into old question paper/question bank/book followed by faculty members. Two set of question papers are prepared for each internal. First set of question paper will be issued on the prescribed date of exam. The second set of question paper is exclusively for the students who have not attended the internal on the prescribed date if the students have any valid reason, he/she will be provided a chance for re-test subject to the approval of the principal. Quality of question papers are checked and final question paper is approved by IQAC Cell. The Answer scripts are evaluated by the respective faculties and distributed to the students for self-assessment of their performance and for doubts clarification.
- The principal keeps a periodic check of the student's performance and takes necessary action for further improvement.
